INTRODUCTION

Meena Acharya is an economist by academic training and a senior feminist scholar who has published extensively in English and Nepali, both in academic and popular formats.¹ Acharya got her first college degree (BA) in economics from Delhi University (1960) and her MS in Economic Cybernetics from Moscow State University (1966). She got her PhD from the University of Wisconsin (1987).

She has been doing research on various aspects of Nepali society—development, gender, macro economy, poverty, politics from a gender perspective for over 45 years now. She worked with the central bank of Nepal, Nepal Rastra Bank for almost 25 years as a member of its research division. In the early 1990s, she worked as the executive director of the academic NGO, the Institute for Integrated Development Studies. After trying active politics for a number of years subsequently, she now does most of her research from the Tanka Prasad Acharya Memorial Foundation. She has also worked as a consultant for many donor organizations. She is also a member of the Board of Directors of the International Association for Feminist Economics and has served many Nepali organizations in honorary capacity.

Acharya has written and co-written several books and dozens of articles and reports that have been published in Nepal and abroad. In the following semi-complete bibliography, Acharya's articles, books, published/unpublished reports, etc. have been listed. I have also selectively listed a few working papers and draft papers presented in the conferences/seminars. I have prepared this bibliography after consulting her recent curriculum vitae, the online catalogs of the US Library of Congress (catalog.loc.gov), World Catalog (www.worldcat.org), the Library of Martin Chautari (www.martinchautari.org.np/library).
