AUTHOR INDEX OF WRITINGS PUBLISHED IN *VASUDHA*

This is a cumulative author index of writings published in the English monthly magazine/journal *Vasudha*. *Vasudha* was an important magazine/journal that was first published in 1957. Tanka Lal Shrestha and Bala Prasad Shrestha were its editors in the beginning. It initially catered to the foreigners in Nepal but by the mid-1960s, it had become an important publication for Nepali scholars and commentators alike.

Vasudha was an influential magazine/journal in its lifetime, and academics, politicians, bureaucrats as well as public intellectuals regularly published their works in it. It was one of the few public print platforms available from the late 1950s through the 1970s. Many important issues were debated in the pages of this magazine/journal even during the high days of the Panchayat, which perhaps was possible for its being an English language publication.

We consider *Vasudha* to be an important source to understand Nepal during the decades when it was published. We have prepared this author index to bring this important archival source into the notice of the interested public. We hope that students of Nepal Studies will find this index useful for their research.

This is a semi-complete index of writings published in *Vasudha*. Although it contains information related to articles, interviews, literature and editorials in most of the issues of this magazine/journal, it does not cover information published in *all* of the issues. This is because we have not been able to find all the issues in the public domain/libraries or in private collections. We have prepared this index using the available collections of this magazine/journal at the Tribhuvan University Central Library and at Martin Chautari Library (whose holdings were recently augmented by a generous donation of copies by Dr Saphalya Amatya and Tanka Lal Shrestha). We have also consulted the private collection
